<p>● City Road Bain, previously City Basin</p>	<p>● Late 1970s</p>
<p>● The 4 acre basin originally extended under City Road. In 1979, it was filled in reducing its length by quarter.</p>	<p>● British Drug Houses, a pharmaceutical company, built these factories in 1909, as well as a factory on Wenlock Basin.</p>
<p>● International Harvester, based here from 1910, assembled tractors for agricultural use. Small tractors were used to pull boats along the canal from 1958.</p>	<p>● The lock buildings were a stable, a forge and a rest room for canal workers. The lock keepers cottage was on the opposite side of the canal.</p>
<p>● Hundred weight sacks of marble chips imported through the docks.</p>	<p>● Islington Boat Club's first base was here. It is now on the opposite side of the basin.</p>
